

FACILITY PERMITS

All vehicles entering the Facility are required to display a transfer station permit affixed to the vehicle.

Permits may be obtained at the Facility.

Permits shall be issued only to residents and taxpayers upon presentation of a current and valid vehicle registration or tax bill.

Renters, both yearly and seasonal, shall show proof of residency such as an electric bill or rental agreement, in order to obtain a temporary permit.

Temporary permits are for out-of-town contractors hauling construction debris and yard waste generated within the Town boundaries. Temporary permits are available at the Facility from the attendants. The owner of the property shall obtain the permit.

If a vehicle to which a permit was affixed is traded or sold, or if the owner wishes to affix a permit to a different vehicle, a new permit shall be issued to the vehicle owner provided the owner continues to be a resident and/or taxpayer of the Town and the old permit is removed.

Any reimbursements for services shall be made payable to the Town of Rye.

RECYCLING INSTRUCTIONS

The following items go into the container(s) or compactor

Corrugated Cardboard

All boxes must be flattened, and placed on platform.

Newspapers

All newspaper on the table provided.

Paper

Place in marked container:
Magazines, catalogues, junk mail, cards and postcards
telephone books, cereal boxes, shoe boxes, white and colored paper, manila folders, envelopes, computer & copier paper, NCR paper and forms, colored sticky notes, note pads.

Plastic Containers

Emptied, rinsed, and caps removed: placed in marked container. Bottles stamped #1 or #2: Milk, detergent, bleach, peroxide, vitamin, juice, etc.

Tin Cans

Separated from Aluminum.

WASTE OIL

See attendants:

Glass

Emptied, rinsed and in barrels according to color.

Aluminum Cans

Separated from tin in tray.

Scrap Metal

Tipping fees apply to some items. See the attendant.

*Car parts, metal roofing
Lawn furniture, appliances,
Grills, Cable, Wire
Webbing and extraneous non-metallic material must be removed*

ASH

Place in marked can.

Clothing Container

A Goodwill container is provided for receipt of good, clean usable clothing.

UNACCEPTABLE MATERIAL

Sealed containers of any kind
Containers of greater than five gallons
Whole vehicles
Fuel tanks of any kind
Household hazardous waste
Industrial waste
Asbestos
Radioactive waste
Explosives
Toxins
Dead animals & carcasses
Dirt, stumps or boulders
Brick or concrete rubble
Tree trunks or limbs greater than five
inches (5") in diameter
Any material listed for HHW collection

SWAP SHOP

The Town operates a Swap Shop at
the Transfer Station.

The Swap Shop is open from 7:30
a.m. to 3:00 p.m., Tuesday thru
Saturday

Items left in the Swap Shop must be
functional, in good shape, suitable for
reuse.

Electronic such as computers, TVs,
radios are not accepted at the Swap
Shop.

BRUSH DUMP

The brush dump is open on Tuesday
and Saturday only between the hours
of 7:30 a.m. and 3:45 p.m.

Brush should be less than four feet
(4ft) in length and less than five inches
(5") in diameter in order to be disposed
of in the brush pile.

Compostable items such as grass
clippings, leaves, etc., should be
deposited in the compost pile located
at the brush pile.

**Parking outside the facility gates is
prohibited**

**HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE
(HHW)**

The Town of Rye participates in two
HHW collection events each year,
which are free to the residents.

One event is held in Hampton in the
spring and the other event is held in
Brentwood in the fall.

Residents must store their HHW
materials until these events are held.

Maximum amount of material accepted
per household per event is 20 pounds
or 20 gallons whichever is the
heaviest.

*Material accepted at the HHW
collections consists of, but is not
limited to, the following:*

Anti-freeze
Fuels
Oil based paints, stains and varnishes
Paint thinner & turpentine
Wood preservatives
Pesticides
Household cleaning agents

***Persons having any questions
or concerns pertaining to their
recycling or rubbish should
see an attendant prior to
disposing of any item.***
