- WIN Waste- Special guest Lydia Tilsley from Win Waste Solutions met with the committee to discuss how her company manages waste- "waste to energy"
 - Trash is picked up by electric truck and brought back to the closest plant where it is sorted- trash that cannot be burned is pulled out from a hopper
 - Burnable trash is condensed into an oven where it is heated to a high temperature and reduced to ash
 - The smokestacks release only water vapor- no dangerous fumes
 - The ash can be used along roadways
 - Question: Is the "waste to energy" model something that can be used by Rye?
 - Today the WIN trucks pick up trash from the Transfer Station but they bring trash to Turnkey Landfill
